What is the certificate program?

- ❖ The Certificate Program is designed to prepare staff to coordinate existing family engagement programs to build effective new strategies to increase academic achievement for students in ECE and K-12 schools.
- ❖ It provides a solid foundation for those new to coordinating family engagement programs and strengthens skills of experienced family engagement staff. Participants will receive practical, hands-on training and tools needed to sustain high quality family engagement programs focused on building strong school-family partnerships to support student success.
- ❖ The training is focused on the specific roles for family/community liaisons: parent recruitment, relationship-based strategies, building on the strengths of culturally and linguistically diverse families, planning and implementing high quality family engagement programs that directly support schools to improve achievement and meet state/federal family engagement requirements, including their LCAP goals and Head Start Performance Standards and framework.

What are the requirements?

- ❖ No prior college coursework or degree is required.
- ❖ To earn a Professional Development Certificate, participants must complete ALL two days of the training.
 - Upon verification of your attendance at the trainings and compliance with any coursework requirements, you will receive your family/Community Liaison Professional Development Certificate.

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What is included in the cost and how can costs be funded?

- ❖ The cost of the 2-day registration includes: a training binder with resource materials, a professional portfolio, text book, and continental breakfast and lunch each day.
- ❖ Schools or districts may consider funding the training costs for family engagement staff using Title I or English Learner family involvement funds, staff development funds, or LCAP funding. Class content is specifically designed to assist districts/schools with their state and federal family engagement requirements and supports LCAP implementation of Goal 3 for family engagement. It is also designed to assist Early Head Start and Head Start programs to meet their family engagement program requirements.

How do I register?
